

### TODDLER - DAILY SCHEDULE

<b>6:30 – 10:00am</b>	<b>ARRIVAL</b> – Toddlers arrive. Teachers greet the children & parents and get pertinent information to care for the child during the day. Parents check to see if the child needs to be changed and wash their hands.
<b>8:00 – 9:30am</b>	<b>WASH HANDS &amp; BREAKFAST</b> - Toddlers have the opportunity to practice eating and drinking independently and talking with their caregivers.
<b>9:30 – 10:00am</b>	<b>DIAPER CHANGING</b> – Toddlers are checked and changed if necessary (depending on the time of morning they were dropped off), hands are washed, tables sanitized.
<b>9:30 – 10:00am</b>	<b>FREE PLAY</b> – Toddlers play with various items in the environment such as blocks, instruments, dramatic play items, puzzles, science materials, etc.
<b>10:00 – 10:15am</b>	<b>CIRCLE TIME</b> – Toddlers sing songs, do finger plays, listen to stories, have puppet shows, review concepts such as letter, colors, numbers, shapes, etc.
<b>10:15 – 10:30am</b>	<b>ACTIVITY TIME</b> – Toddlers have an opportunity to have water play, arts and crafts, use play dough, etc.
<b>10:30 – 11:00am</b>	<b>OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES</b> – Toddlers run, jump and climb. They play with balls, go for walks or rides through the neighborhood & to the local parks.
<b>11:00 – 11:30am</b>	<b>DIAPER CHANGING &amp; HANDWASHING</b> - Toddlers are checked and changed if necessary, hands are washed & tables sanitized.
<b>11:30 – 1:00pm</b>	<b>LUNCH</b> - Toddlers have the opportunity to practice eating and drinking independently and talking with their caregivers.
<b>12:00 – 12:15pm</b>	<b>STORY TIME</b> / Language Development
<b>12:15 – 2:30pm</b>	<b>NAP/REST TIME</b> - Children lay quietly on their mats and listen to music and relax.
<b>2:30 – 3:00pm</b>	<b>DIAPER CHANGING &amp; HANDWASHING</b> - Toddlers are checked and changed if necessary, hands are washed & tables sanitized.
<b>3:00 – 3:30pm</b>	<b>SNACK</b> - Toddlers have the opportunity to practice eating and drinking independently and talking with their caregivers.
<b>3:30 – 4:00pm</b>	<b>OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES</b> – Toddlers run, jump and climb. They play with balls, go for walks or rides through the neighborhood & to the local parks.
<b>4:00 – 4:30pm</b>	<b>FREE PLAY</b> – Toddlers play with various items in the environment such as blocks, instruments, dramatic play items, puzzles, science materials, etc.
<b>4:30 – 5:00pm</b>	<b>DIAPER CHANGING &amp; HANDWASHING</b> - Toddlers are checked and changed if necessary, hands are washed & tables sanitized.
<b>5:00 – 6:00pm</b>	<b>DEPARTURE TIME</b> – Toddlers begin to get picked up for the day. Teachers greet parents and give them pertinent information about how the child's day went. Parents are able to view the child's daily written report as well
